<b>Year 10 HT1</b>	In this half term students will study the ethics of conflict. We will look at religious response to war, and if religion is an enabler or inhibitor.

<b>Year 10 HT4</b>	In this half term students will study the causes of crime and the aims of the justice system. We will look at how different religions respond to the causes of crime, and those who commit them, as well as attitudes towards different forms of punishment.

<b>Year 11 HT1</b>	In this half term students will study different responses to the origin of evil and sin. We will look at biblical, political, and literary sources.

<b>Year 11 HT4</b>	In this half term students will study narratives of lived experience of religion. We will take an interdisciplinary approach to identify how people interpret religious teaching, and the effect this has on others.
