	Content
Year 10 HT1	The focus this term is building on skills from Key Stage 3 to complete a short skills focused outcome. Students will look at the designer Alison Willoughby. They will create a designer fact file on her, which includes samples and responses to her work. Following this they will produce their own outcome based on her work, justifying the connection.
Year 10 HT2	
Year 10 HT3	Term 2 starts their main coursework element. Students will begin investigating their chosen theme, this includes creating mindmaps, moodboards and completing primary research. Students are expected to look at least 3 designers based on their chosen theme; they will create fact files on these designers and produce their own artist responses to them. This will be in the form of designs and practical samples.

Year 10 HT5 Year 10 HT6	Following on from their investigating, students will produce design ideas and develop them before completing a final outcome of their chosen final project.
Year 11 HT1	Students will complete a second coursework project on the same theme as previously. This will follow the same content as previously. Each student will be expected to produce a second final outcome, with a folder containing: Primary and secondary research, 3 designer fact files with responses, designs and developments, final outcome and evaluation

Year 11 HT3	Both Textiles and 3D Design are given a design brief from the exam board. Students will create a scaled down version of their folder work containing Primary and secondary research, designer fact files with responses, designs and developments, and a prototype before going on to complete a 10 hour practical exam, where they will produce their final outcome.
