



KS4 Health and Social Care

	Content
Year 10 HT1	During the first half term students will have an introduction into health and social care. They will focus on the first NEA RO33 Task 1 Life Stages. Students will be taught key vocabulary that will be incorporated into the non-examination assignments (NEA). Focus will be on Development specifically Physical, Intellectual, Emotional and Social and the impact on the Individual with a specific age range. Students will complete task 1a of the NEA by creating a case study focusing on the development of an individual.
Year 10 HT2	During this half term students will look at key vocabulary and factors that affect an individuals development; the factors will be linked to the case study produced for task 1a. Expected and Unexpected life events will be taught this is preparation for Task 2 interviewing an individual. Students will create a set of questions and will carry out an interview. Students will consider the Physical, Intellectual, emotional and Social impact of the life event and consider the needs of the individual based on the impacts of the life event.
Year 10 HT3	During this half term students will look at key vocabulary and sources of support. They will learn about Formal, informal, Charity- Task 3. Students will provide information based on research about the types of research and the support available to the individual in Task 2. Justification of how support will meet the needs of the individual will be explained. Students will learn about Person Centered Values and how these are effectively applied to the needs of the individual.
Year 10 HT4	During this half term students will finalise the NEA ready for submission to OCR. Students will start to work towards the exam unit R032 Principles of care in Health and Social Care settings. Students will be taught Key Vocabulary and Topic Area 1 The rights of service users in health and social care settings. Focusing on Choice, Confidentiality, Consultation, Equal and Fair Treatment, Protection from Abuse and Harm.
Year 10 HT5	During this half term students will continue with RO32- the focus will be on Person Centered Values focusing on the impact on the Service User and Service Provider. Students will complete an assessment.
Year 10 HT6	During this half term students will start RO35 Health Campaigns; this is the second NEA. Students will look at key vocabulary and Topic Area 1: current public health issues and the impact on society focusing specifically on the importance of a healthy society and Public Health challenges within society.
Year 11 HT1	During this half term students will recap on previous learning for RO35 and study 1.3- current health promotion campaigns and their benefits. We will move onto Topic Area 2: factors influencing health , factors influencing health and wellbeing, leading a healthy lifestyle, barriers to leading a healthy lifestyle.
Year 11 HT2	During this half term students will choose their campaign from either alcohol consumption or physical activity. They will complete the tasks- 'How to plan and deliver a health promotion campaign', 'How to evaluate their own performance'. The students will present their campaign. NEA will be submitted to OCR
Year 11 HT3	During this half term students will recap on knowledge for RO32 Rights and Person Centered values. Key vocabulary and Topic Area 3- effective communication in health and social care settings. Focus will be on importance and how to adapt to different situations. Topic area 4- how to keep Service Users safe and key vocabulary will be taught focus on safeguarding, infection prevention, safety and security procedures and measures.
Year 11 HT4	During this half term there will be possible resits for RO35 and revision for RO32. Practice questions and exam papers will be completed to ensure that skills are embedded prior to the exam.
